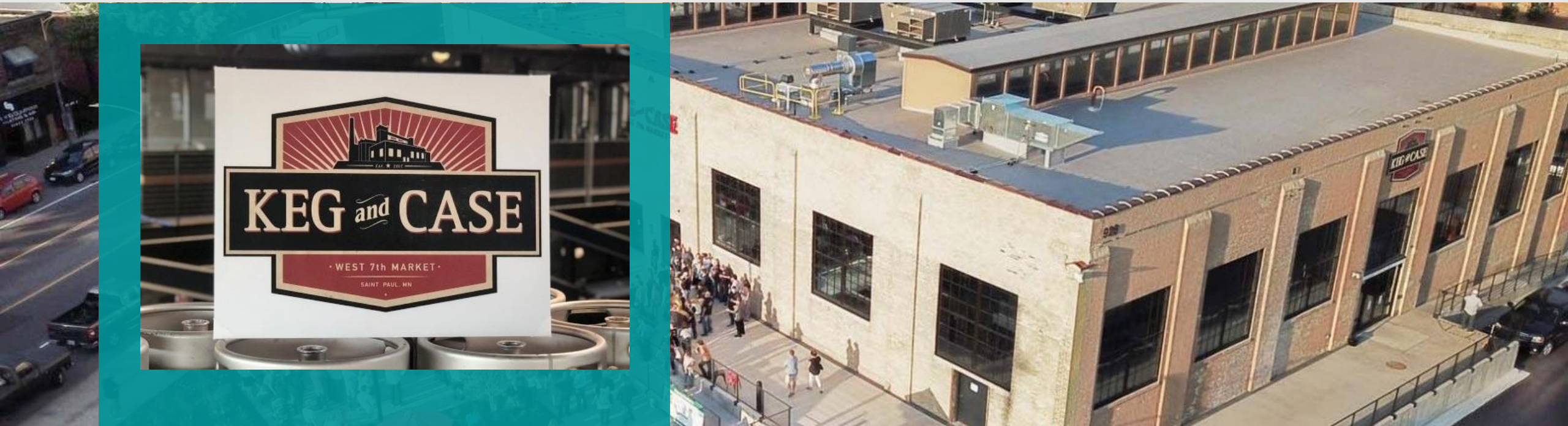


KEG and CASE MARKET for Lease



Located on the historic grounds of the iconic Schmidt Brewery at 928 West 7th Street, Keg and Case West 7th Market is a culinary and retail marketplace – a true community hub for locals and out of town visitors. Keg and Case is poised to become Saint Paul’s most exciting eating and drinking project since beer was first brewed here in 1855! Inside the market you will soon find a combination of restaurants, casual eateries, craft beer brewery, and a market brimming with an eclectic mix of regional goods. Outside, a bustling park is the backdrop for a diverse calendar of music, movies, pop-up markets, and events for all seasons.



Keg and Case Market

- The Schmidt Brewery has been a fixture in Saint Paul's West 7th Street neighborhood since 1855.
- The brewery became the largest in Minnesota by 1860, producing 1,200 barrels annually and shipping them as far south as Tennessee. It was restructured as the St. Paul Brewing Company in 1898 before being sold to Jacob Schmidt soon after in 1900.
- Schmidt Brewery changed hands numerous times before ceasing production in 1990. The Minnesota Brewing Company bought the space in 1991 and once again started brewing. The brewery shut down for good in 2002 and shifted gears to produce ethanol until the doors closed in 2004.
- The bottle and brew houses were converted in 2012 into the Schmidt Artist Lofts, and the former keg house now houses the aptly named Keg and Case Market.
- Now this dynamic building is being re-invented once again with new shops and restaurants in Saint Paul's historic West 7th Street Neighborhood. You can be part of this resurgence.
